
What is it?

A data visualization tool that integrates multiple data sources into a simple visual indicator of the state of recovery of tourism in Canada.

- ➤ Currently three dimensions:
 - ❖ Domestic Tracker Tourism activity undertaken by Canadians within Canada
 - ❖ Inbound Tracker Tourism activity undertaken by non-Canadians visiting Canada
 - Combined Tracker Combines the inbound and Domestic trackers.
- > Scalable, adaptable, not dependent upon a single source of data.
 - Data can easily be added or substituted.
 - Can easily be adapted and expanded to include other concepts, e.g., health/resilience of tourism.


