VARIATIONS IN INVESTIGATION PROCESSES

- Agencies vary in the methods Responsibilities, Powers etc.
- Traditional methods detect, arrest and prosecute
- Alternative processes

STAGES

- 1. Intelligence gathering (Discovery stage supported by external partners)
- 2. Centre of gravity (Military concept, identify vulnerabilities, capabilities, requirements)
- 3. Agreement from Management group to investigate
- 4. Operational Order (Mission statement from manager to avoid mission creep, prioritisation of suspects, lines of efforts to be taken, whether prosecution, disruption, support to other agencies is the planned outcome)
- 5. Investigation plan elements to prove, individual responsibilities etc
- 6. Evidence gathering and recording of management computer system (upload documents and record decisions and sets reviews), execution of search warrants, arrest etc
- 7. Generation of briefs of evidence
