

About the IEA

The International Energy Agency (IEA) works with policy makers and stakeholders to scale up action on energy to mitigate climate change, improve energy security and grow economies while delivering environmental and social benefits.

Energy Efficiency in Emerging Economies (E4) Programme

The IEA has supported governments of major emerging economies in advancing energy efficiency policies and programmes through the Energy Efficiency in Emerging Economies Programme (E4 Programme) since 2014. E4 works closely with six of the largest emerging economies - Brazil, China, India, Indonesia, Mexico and South Africa - as well as within regions, such as Southeast Asia, Latin America and Africa, accelerating energy efficiency.

How we work:

- *Policy development*: we support development of national strategies, targets, policies, regulations and monitoring systems.
- *Research and analysis*: we provide customised research and analysis to support and inform decision making of emerging economy officials responsible for energy efficiency policy.
- *Thematic workshops*: we bring together officials and experts from a range of countries to explore key topics and generate practical, locally-applicable solutions.
- *Capacity building*: we provide training for officials and future leaders, primarily through the E4 Training Weeks and a series of online, self-paced courses.

The first phase of the E4 Programme (2014 to 2017) was made possible thanks to the generous contributions of the Government of Denmark and the European Commission.

The second phase of the programme (commenced in 2018), is part of the IEA Clean Energy Transitions Programme (CETP), which aims to collaborate with partner country governments on all aspects of their clean energy transitions with support from a range of donors including Canada, Denmark, the European Commission, Germany, Italy, Japan, Sweden, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.
