Case Outline

Allegation:

Tax evasion and corruption by unscrupulous businessmen in collaboration with public officers at Kenya Pipeline Company.

Source: Informant

Enabling Law:

Failure to pay taxes, levies, or charges payable to any public body Contrary to Section 45(1)(d) of Anti-Corruption and Economic Crimes Act, 2003.



Investigation Strategy

Question: What is the primary objective?

Answer: To disrupt criminal activity.

What is the plan?

- Surveillance operation
- Financial investigation
- Search & Seizure
- Interview & Interrogation
- Charging and trial



Intelligence Strategy

The Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission





Turning Intelligence into Evidence

- Search and seizure (Obtain warrants to search property and motor vehicle identified during surveillance operation
- Interview suspects and record statements



Prosecution and Trial

- Multi-Agency approach (Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA), Energy Regulation Commission (ERC), Communications Authority of Kenya (CAK), National Environmental Management Authority (NEMA)
- Distillation of available evidence and prefer charges



Challenges & Recommendations

- Legal challenges: EACC does not have prosecutorial powers hence we have to rely on Public prosecutors
- Investigative challenges: Inadequate training and experience on financial/tax crime investigation
- Strengthen inter-agency cooperation
- Training and capacity building in tax/financial crime investigations
