As a leading region for innovation and industry, Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes has everything it takes to drive the energy transition. We have set ourselves a clear objective for 2050: to become the first carbon-free region in Europe.

To achieve this, we are going to invest massively in renewable energy sources. As Europe's leading region for hydroelectricity, we are going to increase our production of renewable energy sources by 54%, thanks namely to the development of methanation, wood energy and solar energy.

Rather than opting to scale back industrial output, our region is choosing to focus on research and innovation by investing in one of tomorrow's key energy sources: green hydrogen. In 2017, in partnership with Michelin and Engie, we launched the "Zero Emission Valley" project to set up charging stations for hydrogen vehicles throughout the region. Thanks to the work we accomplished, Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes is today Europe's main region for hydrogen, bringing together 80% of the players in the sector, including 55 companies and 26 research laboratories.

When we talk about decarbonization, there is one incomparable asset we cannot do without: nuclear power. Nearly a quarter of France's nuclear electricity is produced in Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes, and we are Europe's leading region in this field. We must bear in mind that nuclear power is our major - though not our only - competitive advantage compared to other European countries. In addition, we must remember it is a green, carbon-free source of energy. To meet a challenge as crucial as the energy transition, our country cannot give in to ideology. We need nuclear power, and we will continue to develop it in our region to defend both our jobs and France's strategic interests.

By bringing together all the players in the sector, both public and private, the MIX.E exhibition is a great opportunity to combine our strengths and skills to meet this key challenge for the decades to come: a carbon-neutral energy mix.

France and Europe have set the goal of reaching carbon neutrality by 2050. As it is a forum where multiple sources of energy, multiple solutions and multiple stakeholders converge, it is a unique opportunity to talk, build and move forward together on the path to the energy transition.
