Context



Country: Latinolandia - Tropical hot weather - FIFA WORLD CHAMPION 2022

Sector: School buildings

Characteristics:

- Schools have a significant electrical consumption (second largest)
- Significant number of old and inefficient buildings and appliances (A/C, lighting)
- Many of the current classroom don't inspire learning
- The country already has existing MEPS
- Public schools can be the entry point to other public sector buildings

Schools can serve as living labs to inspire change

Red card to energy waste!

Goal - 20% reduction of baseline by 2030



REGULATION

NEW - Sustainable construction code for existing buildings

- Mandatory for public schools
- Voluntary for private schools

The public sector can lead with example!

INFORMATION

Schools will have access to the equipment catalogs and technical assistance in charge of the Ministry of education..

INCENTIVES

Energy Savings to Scholarships.

Award to the best school energy performance.

Preference to manufacturers and providers of the best energy efficiency solutions

Air conditioning and lighting equipment must be 15% more efficient than the MEPS established in the standard.

The ministry must ensure the validity and relevance of the acquisition of equipment

The government will reward schools with the best energy performance annually with the installation of photovoltaic systems.



Evaluation




Baseline - current consumption
200 kWh/m² (2022)

An **standardized format** with detailed criteria will provide the main inputs for the evaluation of the impact of the policy.

Gender disaggregated indicators will be employed

Comfort and academic performance will be measured
