



#### Terminated:


- Sexual health centers

- First 1000 days of a child's life
- Access to healthcare and medical equipment for disabled

# + 1100 applications for bottom-up initiatives

- Any stakeholder can apply
- No timeline
- On any health topic => no priorities
- Aiming at improving patient pathways, access to care and effectiveness of expenditure in health care\*
- Implementation period of 5 years max




# Nearly complete national coverage




### **Beneficiaries**

Part of each population served for 144 pilots




Payment models	2023


