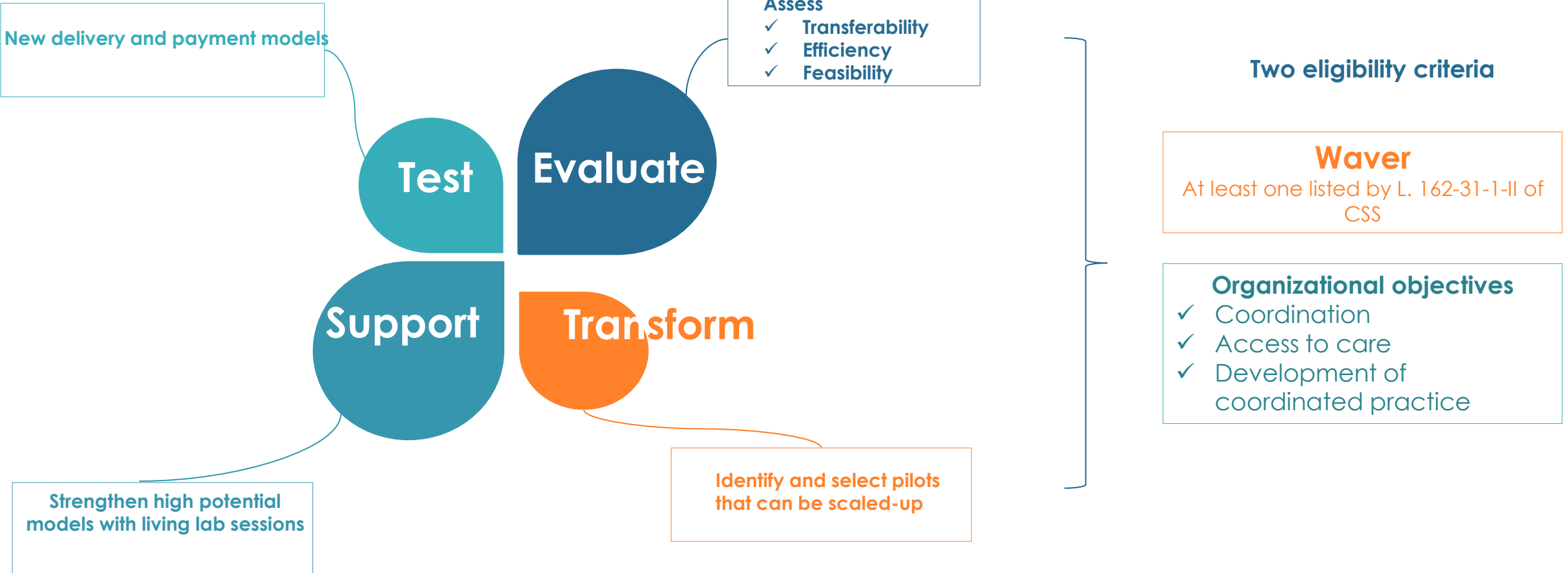
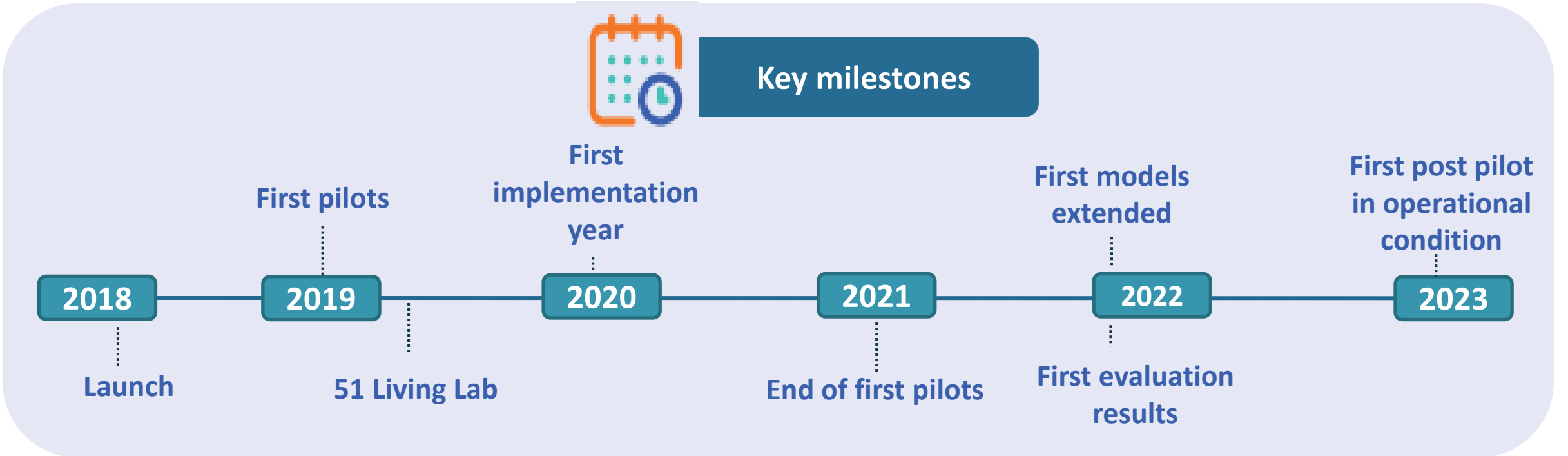

A two-track approach in France

Governmental initiatives

● Ongoing :

- Payment models for primary care (PEPS)
- Bundle payment (EDS)
- ACOs (IPEP)
- Childhood obesity
- Community health centers

● Terminated :

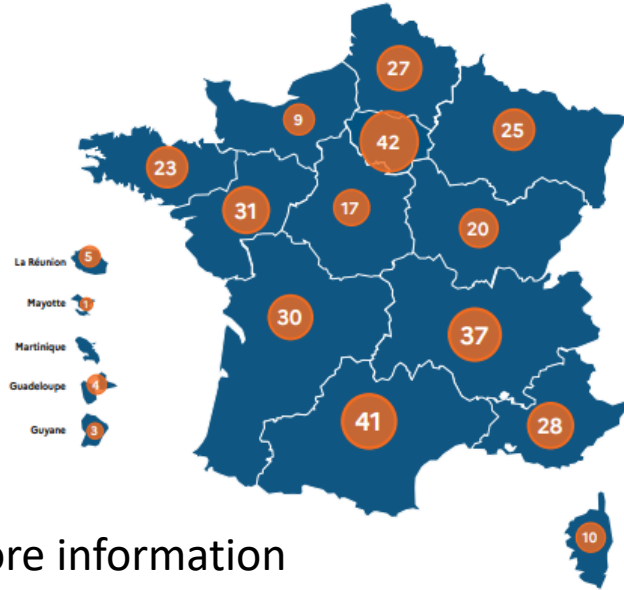
- Sexual health centers
- Emergencies Departments
- First 1000 days of a child's life
- Access to healthcare and medical equipment for disabled

+ 1100 applications for bottom-up initiatives

- Any stakeholder can apply
- No timeline
- On any health topic => no priorities
- Aiming at improving patient pathways, access to care and effectiveness of expenditure in health care*
- Implementation period of 5 years max

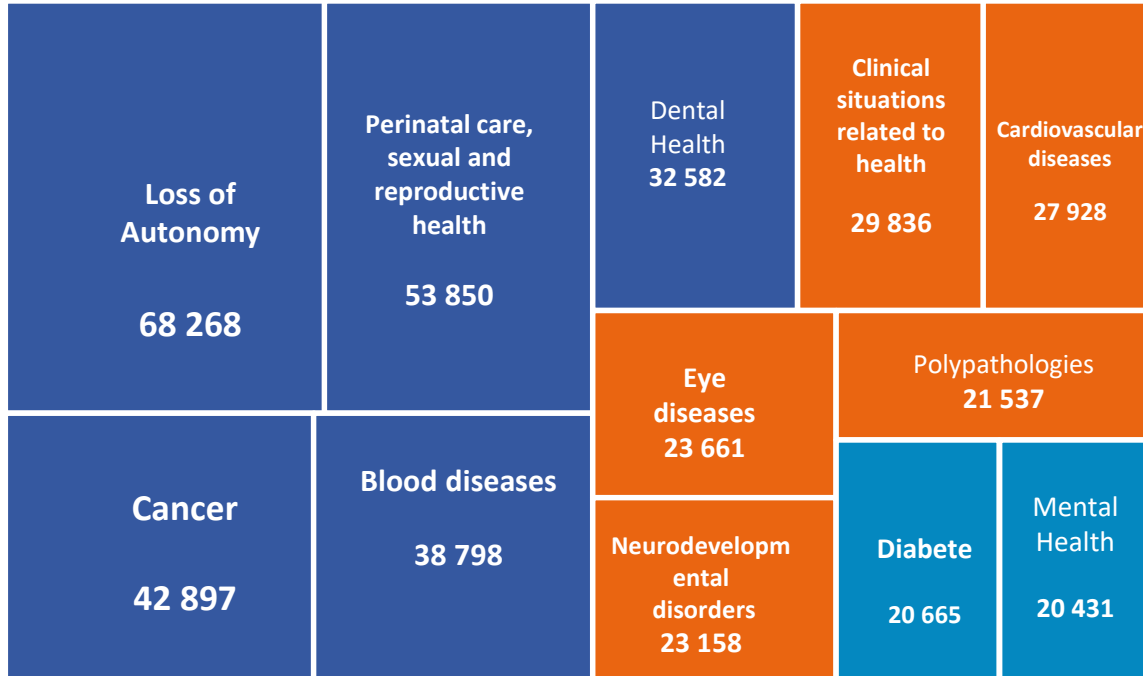

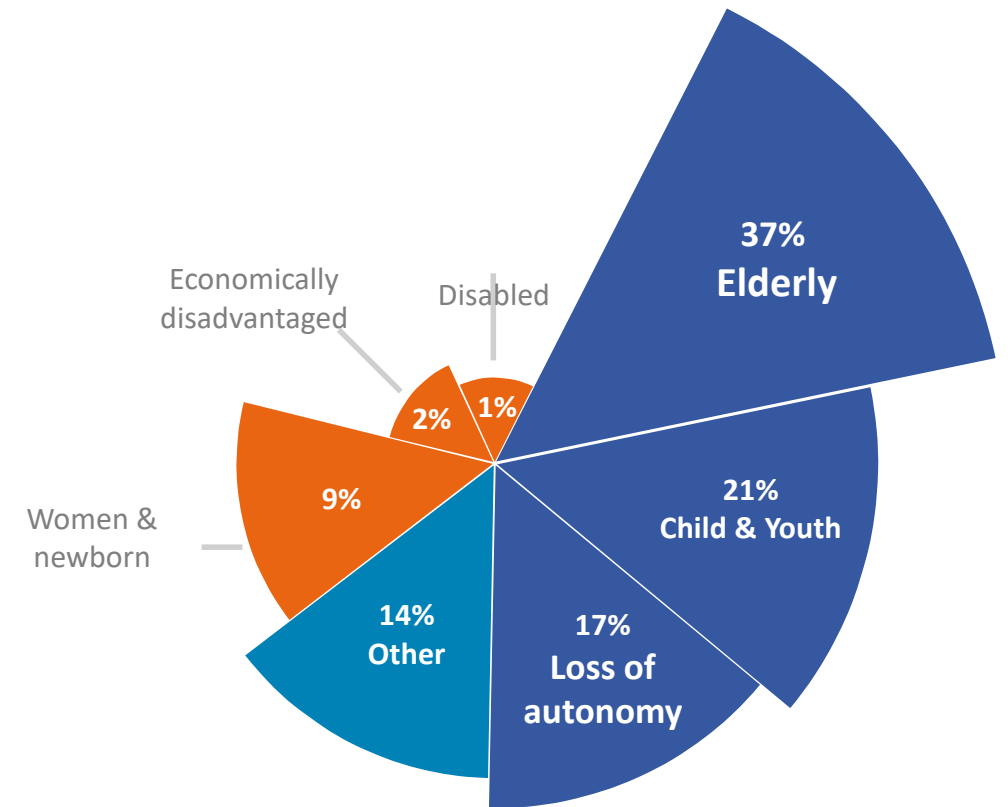

Part of each population served for 144 pilots

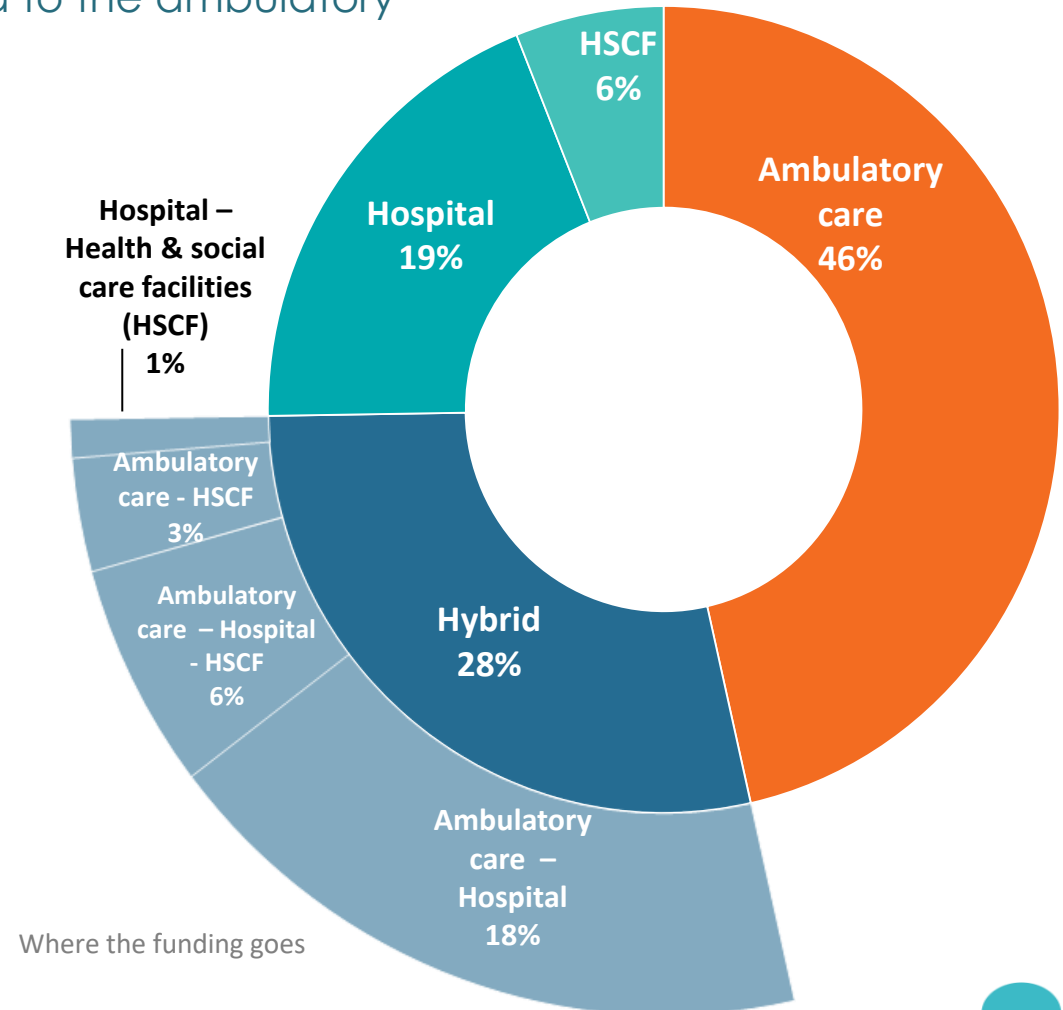

Predominant funding allocated to the ambulatory sector

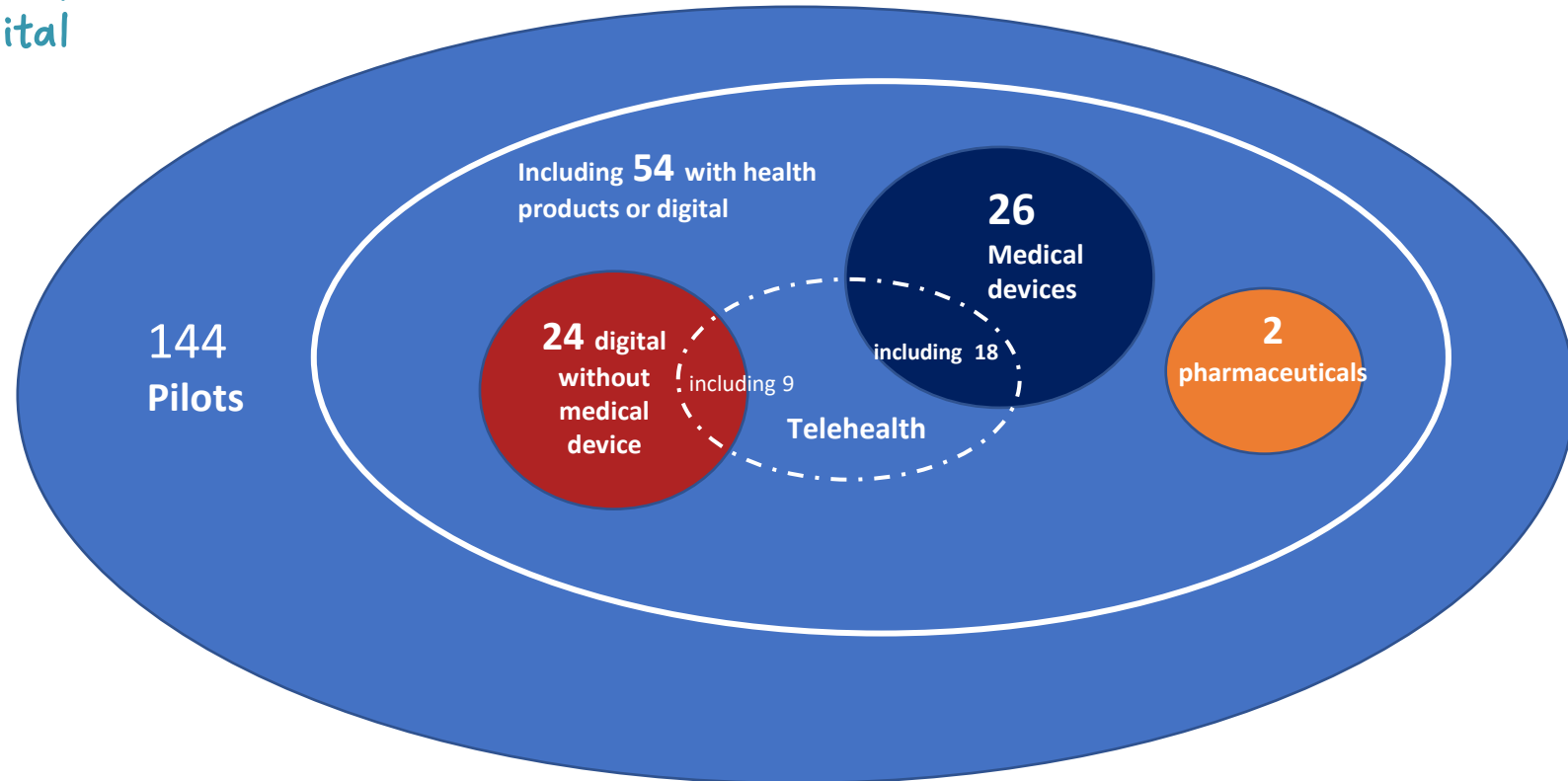
Payment models	2023

Hourly payment	8%
Fee for service	4%
Capitation	6%
Allocation	3%
Variable share-based	4%

Categorization of payment models



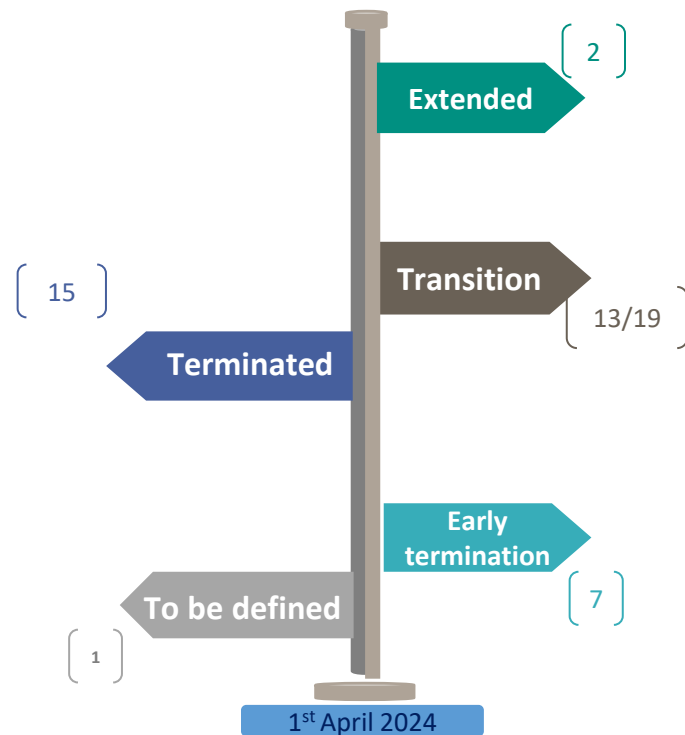
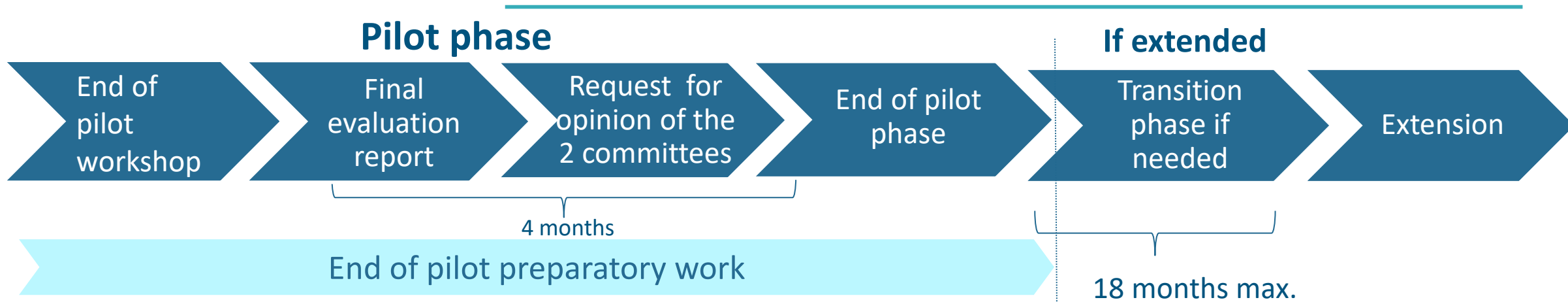
