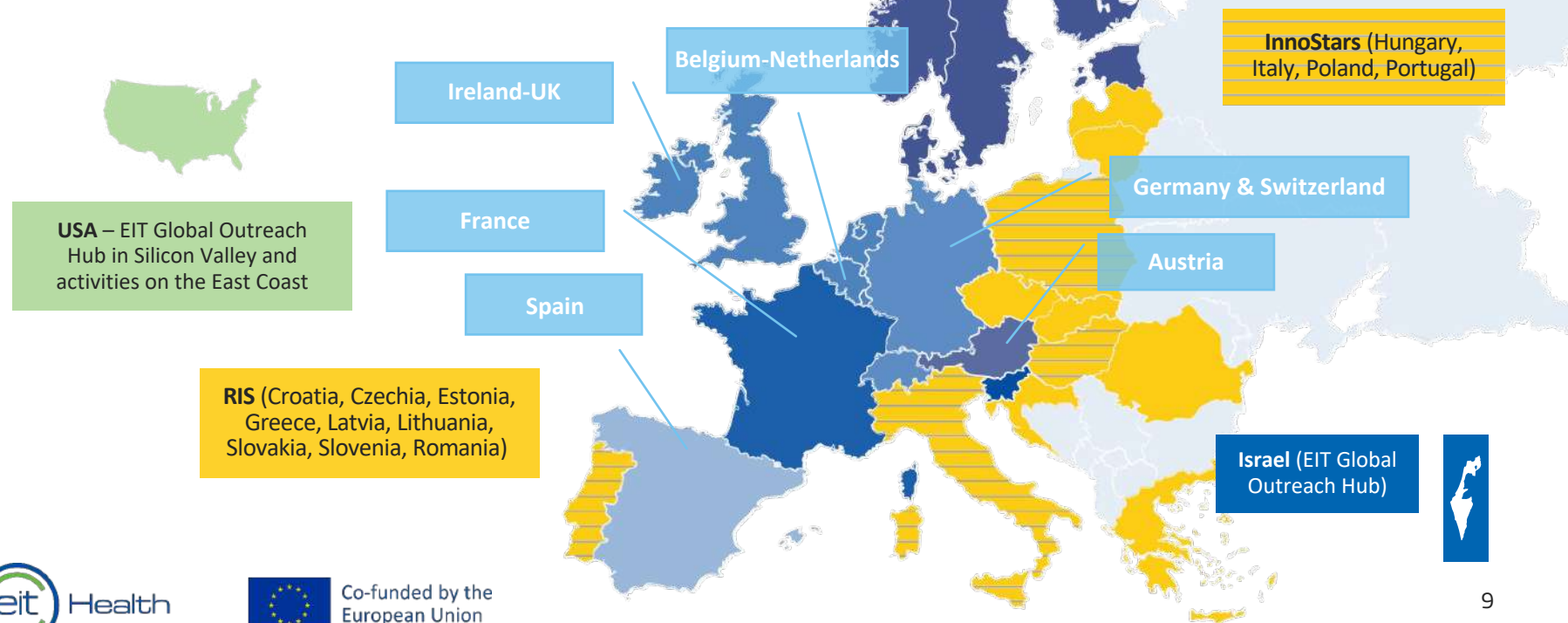

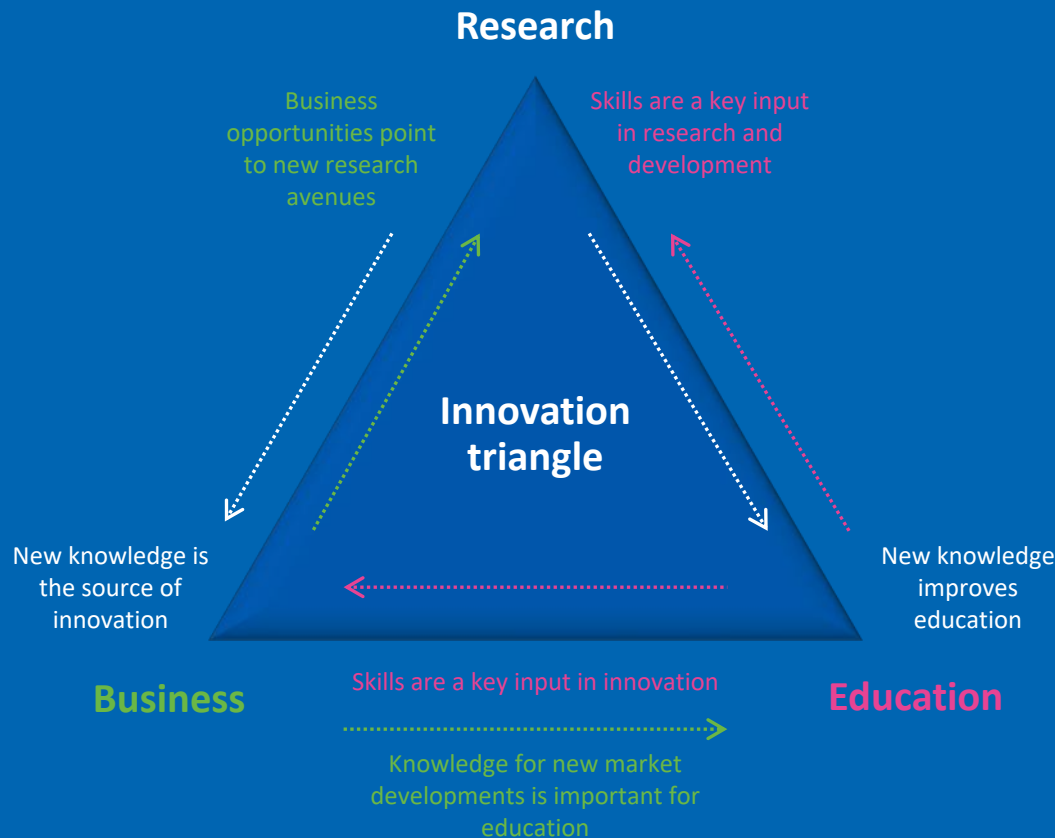

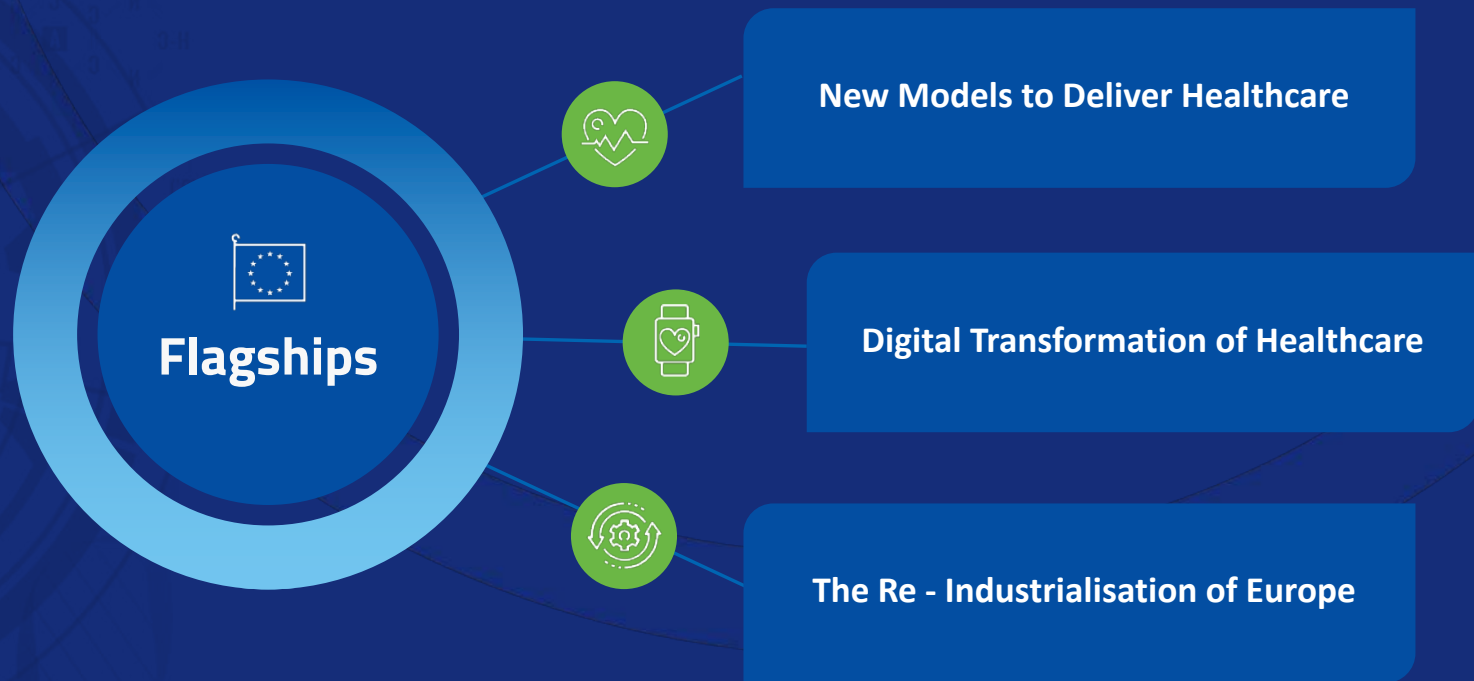


How do we make healthcare innovation happen together?

New models to deliver healthcare

Society is constantly evolving, but healthcare systems can't keep up with our ever-changing needs. This Flagship looks at how we can redefine healthcare models and implement robust analysis of databases in place to establish a foundation for value-based healthcare: one where success measures are based on patient outcomes and a shift from treatment to prevention.



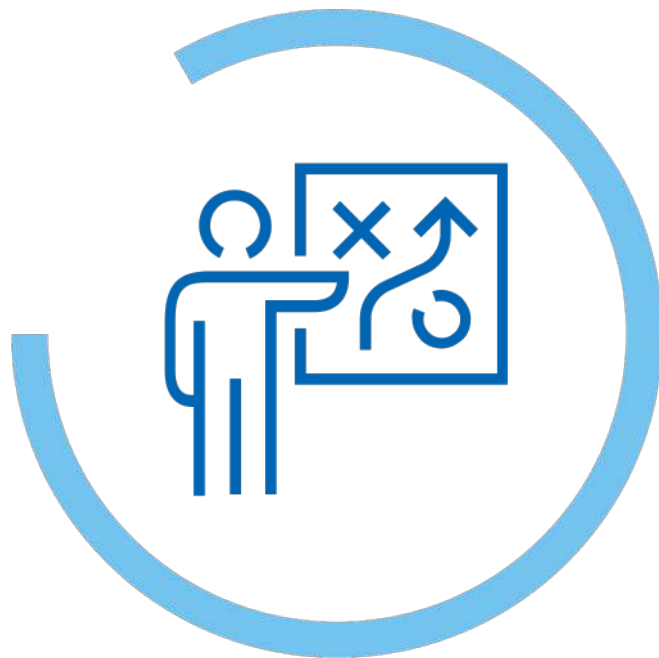
Digital transformation of healthcare

Advanced technology and data utilisation is driving the shift towards digital healthcare to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of medical services. This Flagship aims to support digital health transformation in Europe and has two focus points: the development of, and access to, digital health medical devices, and the implementation of the European Health Data Space by exploring the secondary use of data.



Re-Industrialisation of Europe

This flagship will address two known challenges. It will focus on equipping Europe with a strong, innovative and export-friendly healthcare industry, whilst developing lasting and innovative European manufacturing capabilities regarding critical products, notably within the production of pharmaceuticals.

Technology and Service Development Activities

Service Development activity

- Promote the market uptake of innovative products and services by assessing the quality of the healthcare service improvement. The ultimate goal is to generate sufficient evidence of added value to patients that will convince payors to reimburse based on value.

Technology development activity

- Collaborative SME- or industry-led projects that focus on validation, certification, and market access of patient-centred DMD solutions in Europe to facilitate market entry and wider adoption.

DiGinnovation programme

- Accelerating the uptake of digital health apps by healthcare professionals and patients and expediting market launch of the innovation while easing the reimbursement process.

Education Activities

EIT Health Innovation Days (i-Days)

- Hackathon-like events providing training in innovation, entrepreneurship, design thinking methods, and pitching.

Modules towards a Labelled Fellowship Programme

- Learning journeys with a mix of courses in Innovation and Entrepreneurship, and Flagship-related courses that they chose individually, based on their interests.

Master Degree Programme

- Collaboratively design and implement 30 ECTS of Educational content in Innovation and Entrepreneurship.

Modules towards EIT Labelled Certification

- 6 new courses in Digital Transformation in Healthcare to be offered online through the EIT Health Academy.

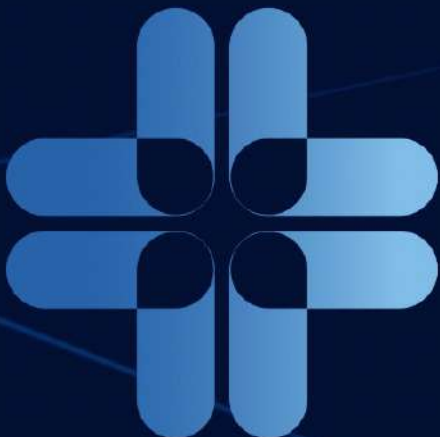

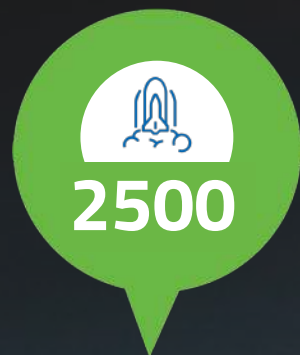
