OECD LAC Regional Programme 17th Steering Group Meeting

CONTEXT

Created in 2016, in response to a greater demand for engagement of LAC countries with the OECD, the Latin American and the Caribbean Regional Programme (LACRP) aims to support the region advance its reform agenda along four key priorities: increasing Productivity, advancing Social Inclusion, strengthening Institutions and Governance, while ensuring Environmental Sustainability. It provides policy makers with a space for evidence-based policy dialogue, peer learning and coordinated policy action, helping LAC countries reach OECD standards and best practices.

The **Steering Group** provides the overall strategic guidance and priority setting to the Programme. It brings together policymakers with a whole-of-government vision from OECD and LAC countries and representatives from partner international organisations (IOs).

The <u>17th Steering Group Meeting</u> will take place on **6 October 2023** in San Jose, Costa Rica back to back to the <u>LACRP Ministerial Summit on Environmental Sustainability</u> at the National Convention Centre in San José, Costa Rica (same venue as the Ministerial Summit).
